



COVID Protocols 2022/23

For the health and safety of students and staff, the Los Angeles Christian School will continue to be conservative and cautious with the COVID-19 protocols. The following COVID protocols are similar to those adopted by the Los Angeles Unified School District protocols.

Protocols:

1. Students and staff will wear masks indoors.
2. Wearing masks outdoors will be optional.
3. Students who experience COVID symptoms should not come to school until they test negative through a home test. If they test negative yet still have significant symptoms (i.e. fever) they should still stay home until the symptoms disappear.
4. Students or staff who test positive for COVID-19 (via school testing or home testing) will be required to isolate at home for at least five days. They can leave isolation on day six, assuming their symptoms are improving, they test negative for the virus and they remain fever-free for 24 hours.
5. Employees who leave isolation after the five-day period will be required to wear a "highly protective mask" at all times in the workplace until 10 days after the initial positive test. Students will be strongly recommended to wear a mask for the 10-day period after they exit isolation.
6. Parents will be notified if a student or staff member in their child's classroom has tested positive. However, students who have been exposed to COVID do not have to isolate unless they have symptoms or test positive.
